Yiu Sing Lúcás Chan, SJ, STL, PhD, a Jesuit priest and a gifted pioneer in the fields of biblical ethics and Asian theological ethics, was a member of the editorial board of *Asian Horizons*.

Lúcás Chan was born in Hong Kong on 7 June 1968. In 1993 he entered the Chinese Jesuit Province. He obtained a Licentiate of Sacred Theology (STL) in Moral Theology (2005-2007) from Weston Jesuit School of Theology, Cambridge, MA, USA and PhD in Theological Ethics (2007-2010) from the Theology Department, Boston College, MA, USA (Dissertation: "Why Scripture Scholars and Theological Ethicists Need One Another: Exegeting and Interpreting the Beatitudes as a 'Scripted Script' for Ethical Living").

His publications include: The Ten Commandments and the Beatitudes: Biblical Studies and Ethics for Real Life (Rowman & Littlefield, 2012; Dharmaram Publications, 2015), Biblical Ethics in the Twenty-first Century: Developments, Emerging Consensus, and Future Directions (Paulist Press). He has also edited the forthcoming, The Bible and Catholic Theological Ethics (Orbis) and Doing Catholic Theological Ethics in a Cross-Cultural and Interreligious Asian Context (Dharmaram Publications). His writings have appeared in America, Asian Christian Review, Asian Horizons, Budhi, Chinese Cross Currents, Colloquia Theologica, and Theological Studies. He held fellowships at Yale University, Georgetown University, and Trinity College, Dublin; held teaching positions in Cambodia, Ireland, Macau, the US, and his native Hong Kong. He was a board member and the Asian Regional Director of Catholic Theological Ethics in the World Church.
