Lukan scholarship. The rather lengthy bibliography and the introduction are a substantial help towards the study of the third Gospel. The introduction which is elaborate, treats the various important questions such as the unity of Luke-Acts, language, history and theology, where we are led to the ideas of the Holy Spirit, Messiahship of Jesus, Kingdom of God, Christians and the world, Christ and Judaism etc. The important literary textual problems are also discussed for instance structure, sources, origin, authority etc.

The commentary moves from pericope to presenting the structure, background and the teaching. This method proves to be interesting and useful. The commentary sheds much light on Luke in this age of charismatic movements and liberation theologies, for which this Gospel is of great importance.
