1. **Dr. Pasang Yonten Arya** *Dictionary of Tibetan Materia Medica*, translated from Tibetan and edited by Dr. Yonten Gyastso, Delhi: Motilal Banarsidass, 1998, pp.xv+310, Rs.395. ISBN: 81-208-1567-x.

The original Tibetan work was published in 1994. This is first dictionary of its kind in English. All the entries are arranged in Tibetan alphabetical order in Tibetan language. This work will be of great use and value for doctors, students and research scholars of Tibetan medicine.

'The author introduces the Tantric methods of Tibetan Buddhism and draws correlations between this practice and the teachings of Carl Jung. In a clear, concise style, Breaux points out how many psychological truths are woven into the fabric of the Tantric doctrine.' The approaches to the psychic phenomena of Tantra and Jungian psychology are from opposite directions. But both try to understand the psychic forces for the good of human beings.

This book studies the historical, theoretical and practical aspects of these two systems scientifically.

Raimon Panikkar is a well-known philosopher, theologian, indologist and professor of comparative study of religion. The present work is an interdisciplinary study, first published by Orbis Books, New York in 1993. The divine, the human and the earthly are the three dimensions of the cosmotheandric principle. This book has two parts and an epilogue. Scott

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Eastham writes the introduction. The first part is entitled "Colligite Fragmenta: For an Integration of Reality", and the second part is "The End of History. The Threefold Structure of Human Time-Consciousness." The Epilogue deals with "Aspects of Cosmotheandric Spirituality".
